Greetings from President Jean Kagan

"If Glendale had an award for the most unique fundraiser, Soroptimist International of Glendale's, "Bras for a Cause" would win every year." Joyce Rudolph, Glendale News-Press, 2016

In 2004, the then Soroptimist International Glendale President, Kathy Lefkovits introduced a new fundraising idea to raise awareness of breast cancer: "Bras for a Cause." The concept was. and is, still very simple. Bras become decorated works of art, are entered into a competition, and are judged. Over the



ensuing 22 years, entries into the competition have demonstrated an amazing breadth of creativity among the contributors. Judges for the competition have exercised their due diligence in their scrutiny of the entries as they have determined the winners.

The decorated bras then become part of a silent auction with all proceeds garnered designated to fund programs which raise breast cancer awareness as well as service grants that provide women and girls with the education and training that they need to achieve economic empowerment.

Since its inception "Bras for a Cause," has raised and distributed over half a million dollars in support of these two women's initiatives.

This year marks our 22nd Annual "Bras for a Cause," The theme for 2025 is Bras Goes Hollywood. Master of Ceremonies for our Gala Evening will be Glendale Councilmember Ardy Kassakhian.

Greetings from Ilena Blicker, Fundraising Chair

Welcome to *Bras Goes Hollywood*, the 22nd Bras for a Cause. We are thrilled that you are here to participate in and support us in our mission to have a positive impact on the lives of women and girls.

The funds we raise allow us to provide scholarships to women who are heads of their family and are going back to further their education with our Live Your Dream program. The funds are also used to provide mentorship programs to teenage girls to



open up the world of careers for them via our Dream It Be It program. We give grants to non-profit organizations in our community that develop programs to assist women and girls to be able to reach economic empowerment.

Among the things I was taught as a child, was that "to save a life is to save the world." I would like to paraphrase that as "to improve the future life of a woman or a girl is the first step to improving the world."

Honoree Ruth Sowby



Ruth started her career in journalism at 20 years-old as a KABC-TV staff reporter in 1964. At that time, she was the only woman reporter in Los Angeles TV news. She commuted to the station every day while enrolled in UCLA for four years. After receiving her Bachelor of Arts degree as an "Outstanding Senior," Ruth continued in TV news, receiving an Emmy Award for her work at KNBC-TV News and another Emmy for "Rose & Katz," a narrative short film she produced, directed and co-wrote at AFI.

Turning back to her education, Ruth received three Masters' degrees from The American Film Institute (AFI), California State University at L. A. and the University of Southern California (USC) respectively. She also received a doctorate from USC in 2001, as well as the honor of "Best Dissertation" for 2001.

Deciding she was educated enough, Ruth began teaching English at Glendale Community College and writing a column for the Glendale News Press, a local media outlet of the Los Angeles Times. In 2013, she was designated a "Woman Achiever" by Business Life magazine.

Deciding she was funny enough, Ruth began stand-up comedy after watching comic Richy Leis host "Bras for a Cause" in 2019. Leis became her teacher and mentor. Today, Ruth is a reporter-photographer for the Crescenta Valley Weekly by day and a comedian by night. After turning 80 in 2024, her most recent stand-up set was at the Hollywood Improv Comedy Club.

Ruth is most proud of her family, husband Richard Rands, son Anson Sowby, daughter-in-law Roberta Sowby and two grandchildren, Luke, 15, and Sienna, 11.

She has served as a board member of many non-profit organizations, all of which promote supporting issues relating to the education, learning challenges, housing, health and wellness of children. The organizations include Glendale Kiwanis, Ascencia, Glendale Education Foundation, Cabrini Literary Guild, & Las Candelas. In addition, she has been an active sponsor of Home Again LA, Glendale Arts, Glendale Latino Association, YWCA Glendale-Pasadena the Salvation Army, and Soroptimist Int'l Glendale. Karen has received the Woman of the Year Award in 2020 from Glendale Latino Association and Business Life Women Achiever Award in 2017.

Mike after serving in the army, found that his father had left his successful employment as a manufacturing rep to found his own company. Mike joined his father in this new enterprise, which became the manufacturing arm of the rep business. The new firm was named by Mike, Crystal Mark. They were shortly joined by Mike's 2 brothers and over time expanded to three companies, Crytal Mark, CrystalMark Dental Systems and Cygnet Metal stampings. Mike is President of CrystalMark Dental Systems.

A week after Karen joined Kiwanis of Glendale in 2012, Mike joined so as not to miss out on anything. Together, they have both enjoyed working on many of the projects of the club and the friends they have made there.
